Weird or Wonderful?

Winning *The Greatest Spectacle in Racing* naturally has attracted many an odd or innovative design over the years, especially when small independent race teams and individual mechanics could freely apply their creativity and energy in pursuit of their dream, without being stifled by restrictive formulas and by the threat of losing the support of large advertisers or sponsors. And build them and bring them to race they did! What follows are just some of the interesting examples.



Left: Entered and built by Sampson Motors, this Stevens chassis was driven to 6th place in 1940 by Bob Swanson. *I could have had a V-8*! But it's engine, in fact, was a 183 cu in V-16, made by putting together (2) 91.5 cu in 8-cyl Millers in the form of a "V" over a common bottom end and crankshaft. 1956 winner Sam Hanks also drove it in 1946.

Below left: In 1948-49, the Pat Clancy Special, a six-wheeler, featured four-wheel drive in the rear from twin rear axles. Driven in '48 by Billy DeVore, it was amazingly fast down the straightaways, but lacked finesse in the corners. Pictured here is the effort in 1949, in the hands of Jackie Holmes, which failed to finish the race again. *Photo:_http://www.mgussin.freeuk.com/PatClancy/PatClancy/Special.htm*

Below right: Preston Tucker, to promote the Tucker "car of tomorrow" concept, entered this rear-engine four-wheel drive Miller design in 1946. (It was the survivor of the








three Harry Miller had built for Gulf Oil in 1938.) The *Tucker Torpedo Special*, with George Barringer, was forced to retire after 27 laps with gear problems.


Left: Innovative racecar designer Smokey Yunick brought this "sidecar" *Hurst Floor Shift Special* to Indy in 1964. It not only attemped to shift the weight of the engine, drivetrain and chassis to the left, but also positioned the driver in a control pod sidecar to the inside between the rear and front wheels. Tested by Indy veteran driver Duane Carter, Sr, an official qualification effort was finally made on the last day by rookie Bobby Johns, but he lost control and severely damaged the car, which never raced again.

Top left: In 1955, Terre Haute native Chapman Root, whose family glass business had designed the Coke bottle in 1915, poses proudly behind his entry, the Sumar Streamliner Special. Underneath the sleek futuristic body was a Kurtis-Kraft D chassis powered by a Meyer-Drake Offenhauser engine. Wabash's Jimmy Daywalt, who was Rookie of the Year in 1953 driving for Root, found the car especially unstable in the turns and suffering from excessive drag due to air buildup inside the fenders. Finally, in desperation, the entire outer body was removed, revealing its ugly inner body panels and side-mounted oil cooler. *Top Photos: http://www.angelfire.com/in4/jimmydaywalt/Misc.htm*




Top right: A relieved Daywalt is shown after his qualifying run. Starting 17th, he finished the race in 9th place.



Mid left: Preston Tucker and partner Harry Miller were to build ten of these V8 Ford-powered cars for Henry Ford for the 1935 500. They delivered eight by the Race with only four making the field. All dropped out with steering problems, undetected during the short time available for pre-race testing. Mid right: Lou Fageol, President of the Twin Coach Bus Company who also manufactured trucks, delivery vans and even parts for the early US jet plane, the F-80 Shooting Star, constructed a bizarre 1946 four-wheel drive entry by combining two of these 1935 Miller-Tucker-Ford chassis front halves back-to-back. He dropped in two 91 cu-in Offenhauser midget engines, one in the front and one in the rear, each supercharged by Roots-type blowers. Photo: IMS Official Trackside Photo Shop, cropped and tinted Bottom left: Paul Russo, driver of the Fageol Twin Coach Special, put the rear-finned car in the middle of the front row, but crashed after only 16 laps in the race. Bottom right: Fageol, himself a long-time, noted powerboat and hydroplane driver, won the Gold Cup three times, the President's Cup and the Harmsworth Trophy. In 1955, while qualifying the famed unlimited hydroplane Slo-mo-shun V, a 28-ft









long, 12-ft wide, 4850 lb behemoth powered by a WWII era Rolls-Royce Merlin engine, he experienced a complete 360 degree back flip. Fortunately, the boat landed right side up, and Fageol was able to walk away from it. (Well, maybe not literally!). *Image: Cropped from an original painting by artist Jim Collier*
