Miscellaneous Meanderings

The January Moss Motoring magazine had an interesting article about having club safety inspections of our cars. The cars (and us) are not getting younger, and it's easy to miss some issues that could ruin a weekend (or more). It's easy to get used to some minor noises that

could indicate something is about to go wrong. This is a good idea for one of the tech sessions at Jim's garage.

As an example, I felt the brakes pulling to the right a little and had added 'bleed, adjust brakes' to my list of things to do. While I had it jacked up, I noticed that brake fluid was leaking from the left front. I'm not sure how long it had been leaking. Adding wheel cylinders and shoes to the list!



Hopefully you don't ignore a 'minor' brake squeal this long!

I pulled the rear springs on the bugeye expecting to see the driver's side spring had flattened out. Surprisingly both of the springs are in good shape. Likewise, the spring boxes are good. I'm cleaning them up, putting graphite paint between the leaves, and painting the springs before putting them back in (swapping sides), then I'll play with some shims to even out the ride level.



Craig recently talked to Bill Oesterle and asked about the Cars and Gravy events. As a result of their conversation Amy Bosworth contacted me about the events. They started the events last year as a free event for the community. They are held at the old Indiana National Bank at
