My brother went through a bunch of his old magazines and found a Road and Track and a Sports Cars Illustrated from 1958 with road tests of the \$1795 Sprite when it was first introduced. I agree with most of the observations of the articles, except their dislike for the headlights – that's what makes a Bugeye! It's smiling back at you. SCI complemented the Sprite for it's luggage area, but made the following observation if the spare tire was needed: 'BMC would have no trouble marketing, as an option, a trained monkey to load and unload the spare and tools.'

As far as speed, SCI said the car is capable of 90 MPH (they didn't try) based on the RPM at 60 MPH. '..there is every indication that over a prolonged stretch of still air, level -ground road (all right, maybe assisted by a down grade or two) the Sprite will reach it's readline in fourth.'
